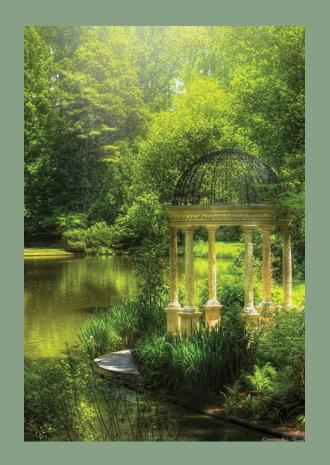


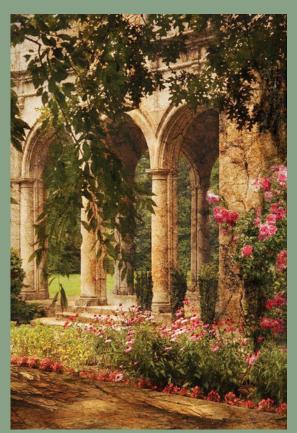


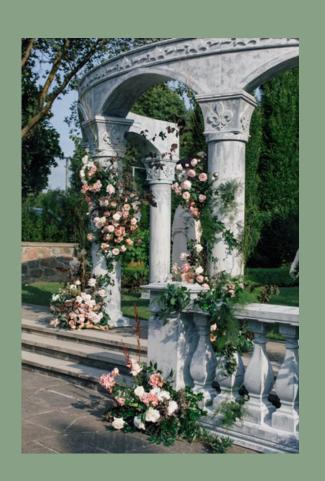


## PROPOSITION

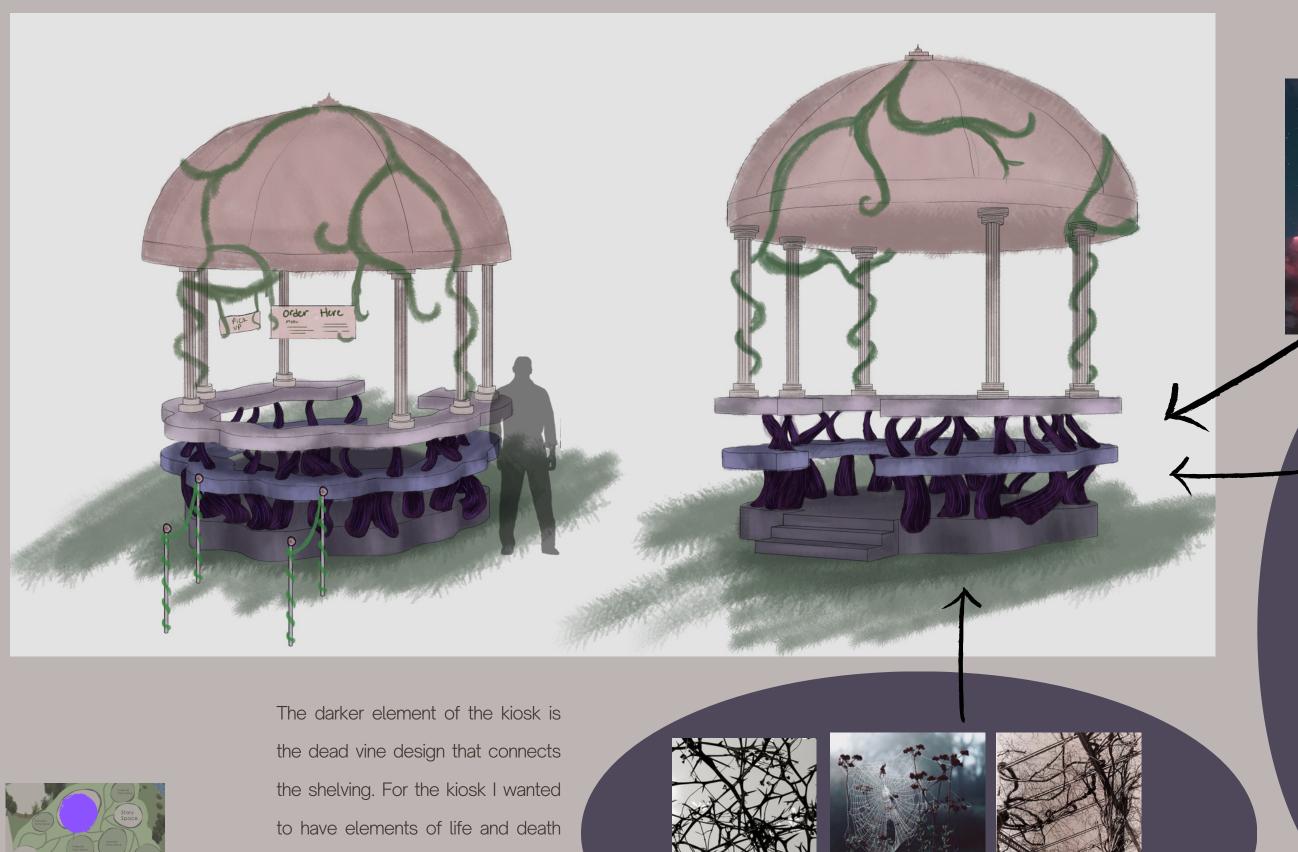






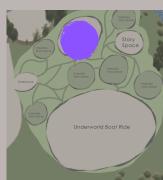


# FOOD AND BEVERAGE KIOSK



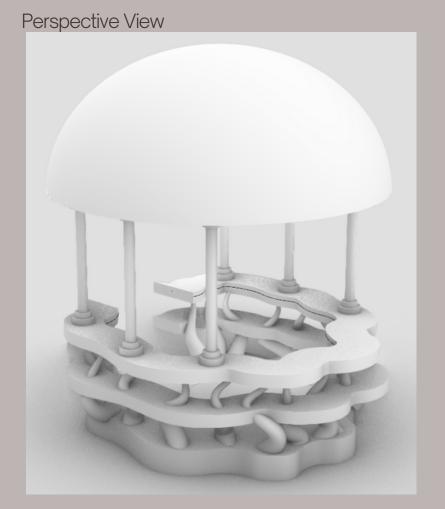
I was inspired by pink and purple clouds for the organic shaped shelving to emphasis on the fact that Persephone is a goddess and that she is not from the mortal world

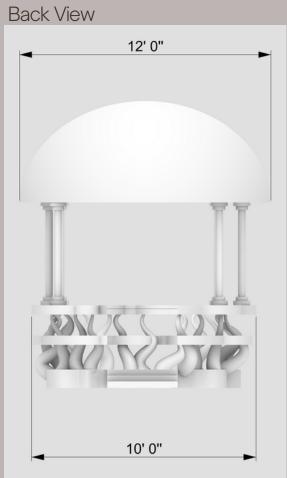

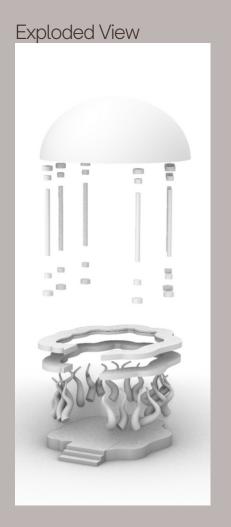


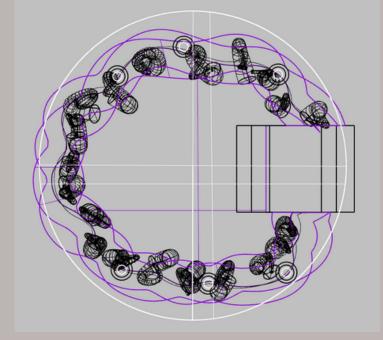
and I did this by having the dead plant design and live plants that cover the top part of the kiosk.

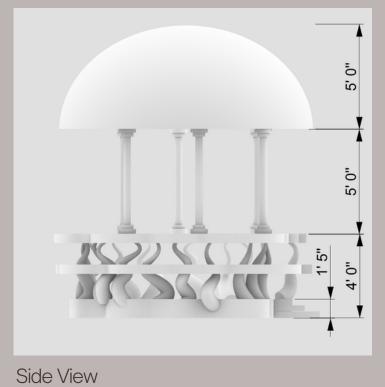

## STORY EXHIBIT 2: WHAT HAPPENED TO MINTHE?

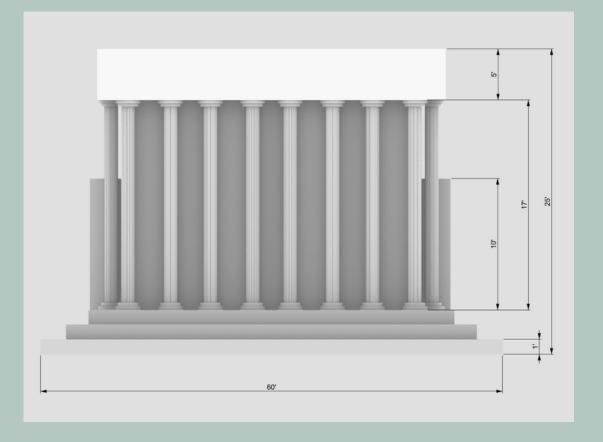

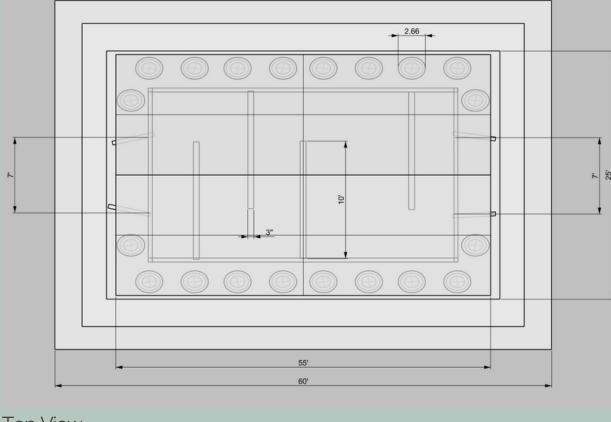
The facade will purposely look worn down. Guests will experience Minthe's memories coming to life so as guests go further into the experience things will appear newer and will see shadows of Minthe.



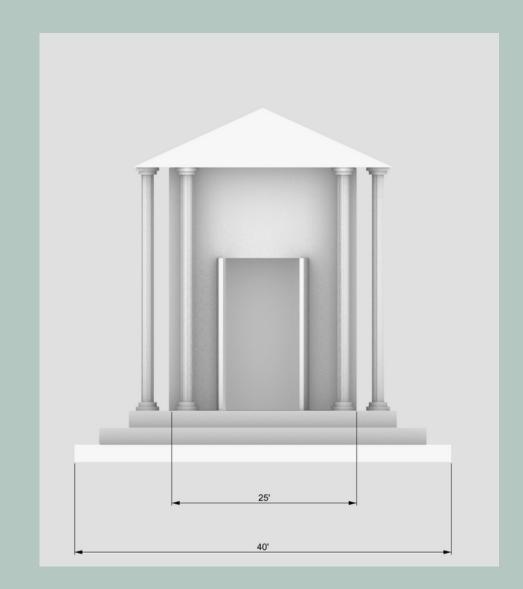

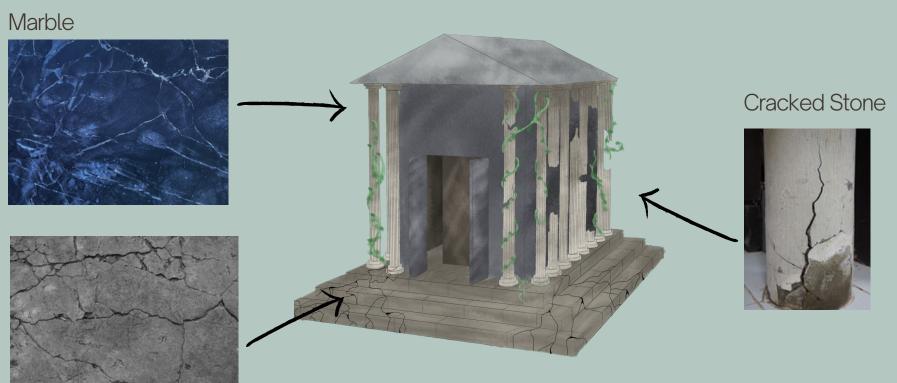

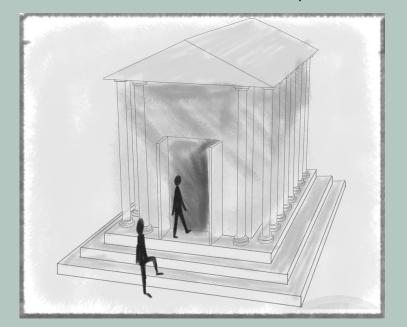

### Story Board of Guest Experience



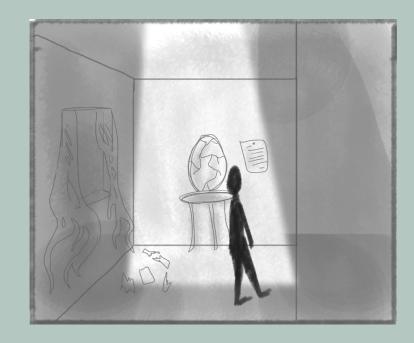
Facade of Experience



Scene 1: Guests will first see a mural with projections and lights showing the flowing River Styx and Minthe playing in the water.



Scene 2: The second scene is a series of gifts from Hades to Minthe. Here guests will hear Minthe singing and laughing in the background and warmer lights are used in this room.



Scene 3: Guests will enter the third room where Hades has told Minthe he is in love with Persephone. Guests will hear things being shattered and crying in the background. There will be cooler lights creating a darker atmosphere. It will also feel colder in this room.



Scene 4: The first part of scene four guests will see
Minthe trying to convince Hades to come back to her and
leave Persephone. This will be done through silhouette
projections.



Scene 4: The second part is where Persephone interrupts the conversation and things become heated between Persephone and Minthe.



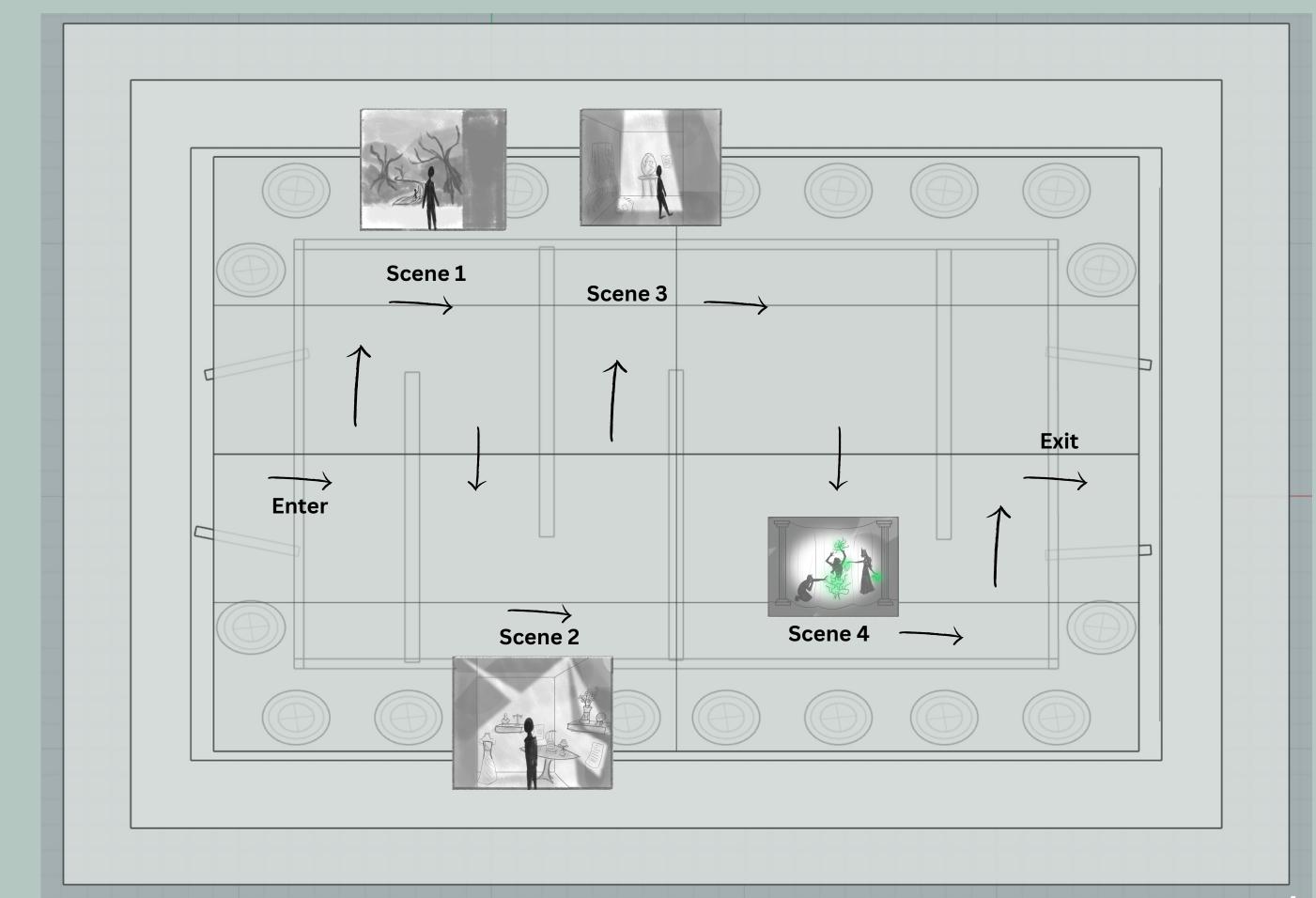
Scene 4: Green magic blasts from Persephone's hand and around Minthe. Minthe screams in horror as she realizes she is being turned into a plant. Hades is crying and begging Persephone to stop.



Scene 4: In the final scene guests see mint growing everywhere. Persephone leaves the room, and Hades is left weeping over Minthe.

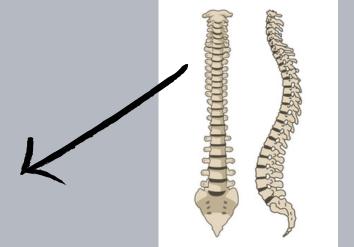

# RIDE VEHICLE DESIGN

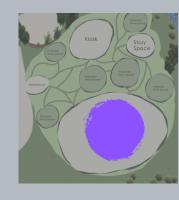




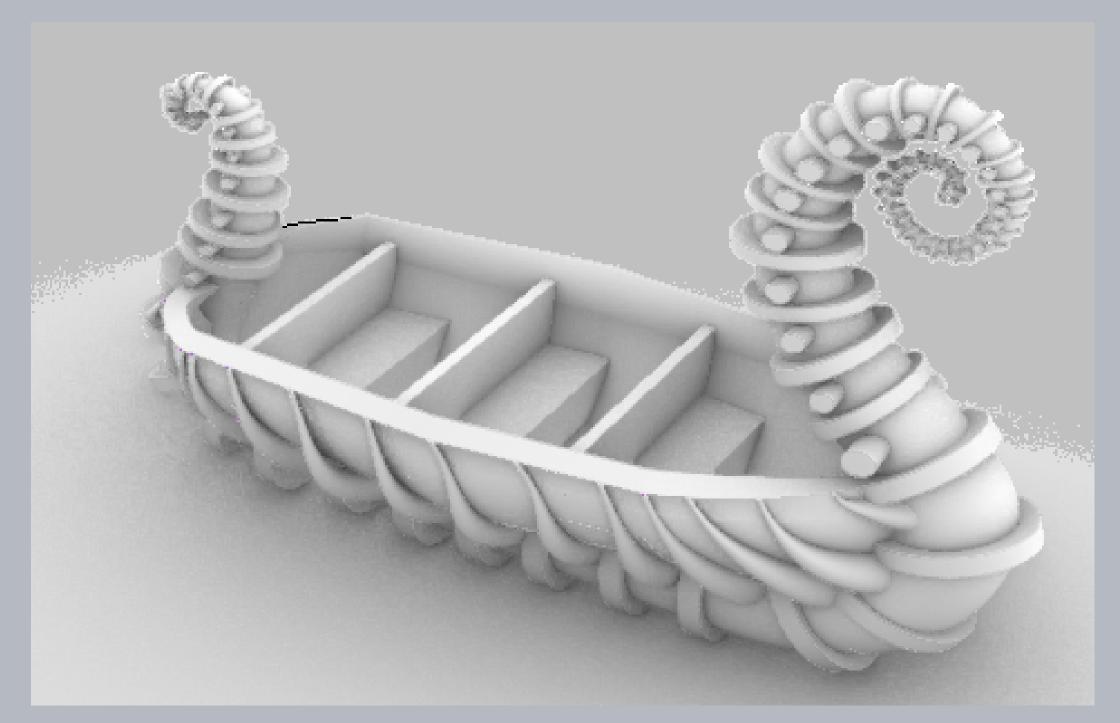
The design was inspired by the anatomy of a human spinal cord.

The ride vehicle design is meant to feel like it is decaying.

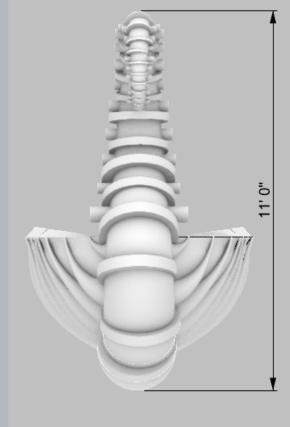
The goal of the design is to create a sense of uneasiness, which is a contrast to the welcoming environment the rest garden has.

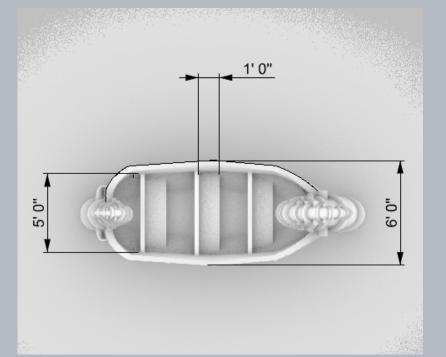


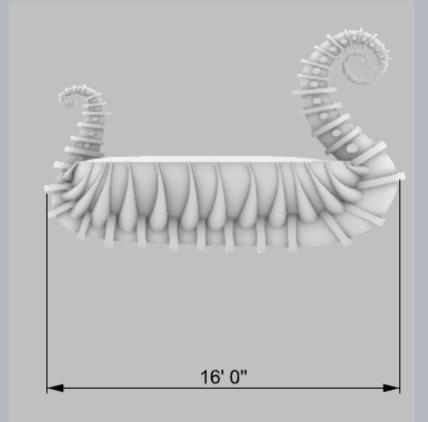

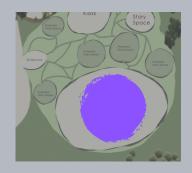

## ATTRACTION INSPIRATION

The ride vehicle design will be for the boat ride that is featured in Persephone's Garden. The boat ride is a slow paced attraction along the River Styx which flows through part of the garden and into the Underworld.
